






An animal is a living thing with multiple cells in its body that has organs, eats, breathes, moves on its own, and reproduces.





Exists in the False Self


Sinornithosaurus millenii Though a classic dromaeosaur tail establishes that it is a dinosaur, other skeletal features closely resemble those of birds.


Archaeoraptor liaoningensis Preliminary studies show that this specimen has startling similarities to both dinosaurs and birds.


